## **Rescue/Transport Volunteer**

SoCal Parrot receives emergency calls from San Diego to Pasadena to Ventura, and everywhere in between. Since these are usually urgent cases, we rely on our team of volunteers to respond quickly and transport the bird from where it is found back to our facility in Jamul. The long-distance rescues often require multiple volunteers to drive one part each. Every rescue situation is different, and we cannot guess as to when or where they will come up. Prior to joining our team, you will receive training from SCP staff, along with full support during each rescue.
