



Parrot Care Volunteer

SoCal Parrot houses and cares for over 150 wild, naturalized parrots. The birds in our care range from adults to nestlings, and are often injured or recovering from injury or illness. With so many living beings to care for, we rely on assistance from our volunteers to help out with daily care tasks. As a Parrot Care Volunteer, you will provide support with basic husbandry tasks, with the option for more in-depth responsibilities like baby feeding or administering medications. This role is ideal for someone who wants to gain more hands-on experience with parrots and has a few hours a week to help out at our facility.

Responsibilities

- Remove, clean, and replace water and food dishes
- Sweep, rake, and scrub cages, perches, and enclosures
- Assist staff with food prep
- Build and maintain enrichment and perching
- Assist staff with caring for rescued patients
