Rescue and Transport Volunteer

SoCal Parrot receives emergency calls from San Diego to Ventura, and everywhere in between! Since these are often urgent cases, our team of volunteers helps us to respond quickly and transport the bird from its original location to our facility in Jamul. Long-distance rescues often require multiple volunteers to drive individual legs. Every rescue situation is different, and the hours and timing vary greatly. Transport volunteers receive training from SCP staff during orientation, and have full support during each rescue.

Responsibilities and Tasks

- ◇ Respond to group text messages
- ◇ Travel to rescue locations
- ◇ Transport injured birds
- ◇ Interact with members of the public

- ◇ Are comfortable driving!
- ◇ Want to learn basic parrot handling skills
- ◇ Enjoy educating members of the public
- ◇ Aren't able to commit to a weekly shift

Requirements

- ◇ At least 18 years of age
- ◇ Ability to receive group text message
- ◇ Possess own vehicle, driver's license, car insurance
- ◇ Flexible availability
